Guidelines for the Video Presentation

- **Rules**

- Failure to comply with the conditions or rules of video submission may result in the participant's disqualification or the forfeit of the team's prize.
- The video presentation should not contain any improper materials including foul language, violence or pornography.
- The participating organizations reserve the right to modify or amend the prizes, rules and conditions of the competition at any time.
- OLPC holds all the intellectual property rights for all materials by the participating teams for the competition.
- Any kind of plagiarism is strictly prohibited and will lead to disqualification of participants, duplication of the thoughts or work of other sources shall be referenced.

- **Format**

- The video should be in .wmv format.
- All video clips should be uploaded to the assigned server.
- The length of the video should be 3-5 minutes.
- Your fund-raising ideas can be presented in any formats or layouts, including standardized business presentation, drama and commercial advertisement etc as long as the presentation is concise and clear.
- The file name is your team number: Team_number.wmv
- Any languages can be used but they should be clear and understandable.
- Subtitles in any languages are optional.
